To apply for a Post-Doctoral Associate position, the minimal qualification is a doctoral degree in any branch of humanities, natural sciences or social sciences, coupled with strong interest and passion to work in any of the broad areas as above. The application for post-doctoral associate position should be accompanied with the name, address and email id of three to four Referees, and also pdf files of two publications.

To apply for a Research Associate position, the minimal qualification is a post-graduate degree in any branch of humanities, natural sciences or social sciences, (or a graduate degree in medicine or engineering) coupled with strong interest and passion to work in any of the broad areas as above.

How to apply: You can apply with a Statement of Purpose pertaining to any of the broad areas given above, along with your CV, and a scanned copy of the degree certificate.

POSITION OF RESEARCH ASSOCIATE IN "COMMUNICATION AND OUTREACH"

How to apply: If you have expertise and experience in content editing (video and text), Web design, Video documentation, Video and graphic editing, DTP and preparation of web material, you can apply with your CV and copy of your degree certificate.

How to apply: If you have expertise and experience in offering assistance to office and file maintenance, effective correspondence, keeping track of assignments, and help the project leader and her team towards networking, and maintaining timeline, and other related secretarial responsibilities, you can apply with your CV and copy of your graduate degree certificate.
